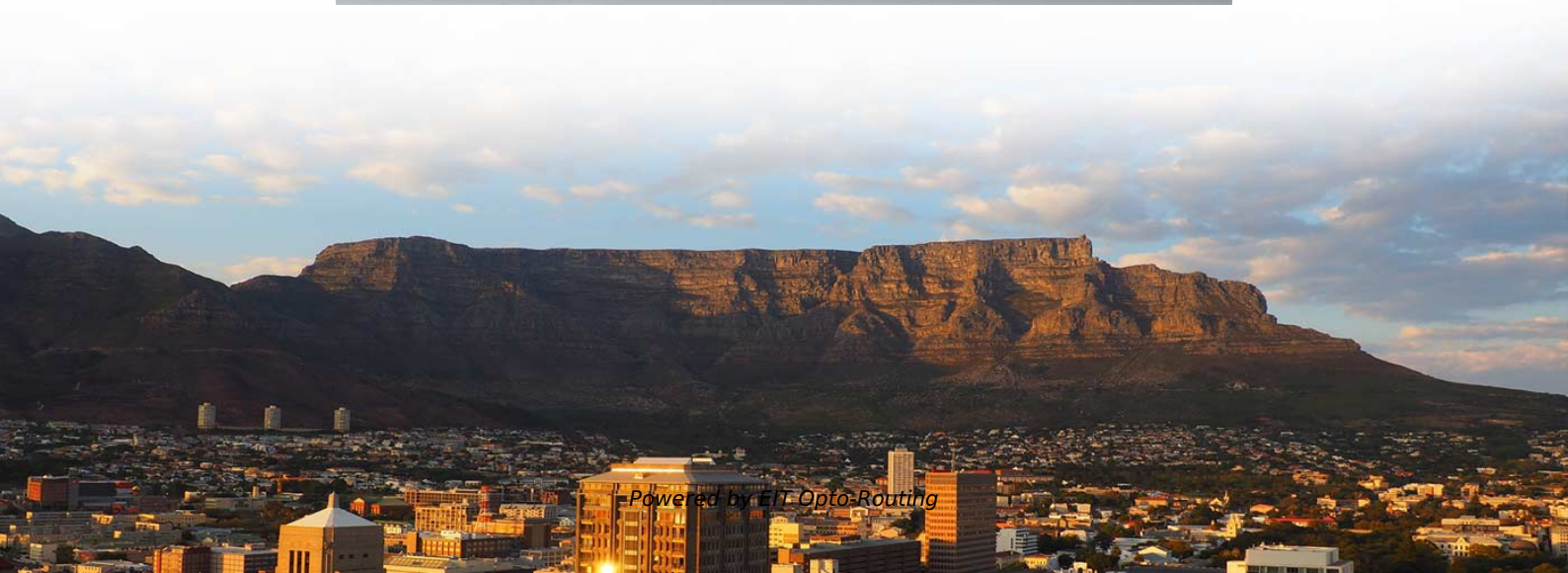
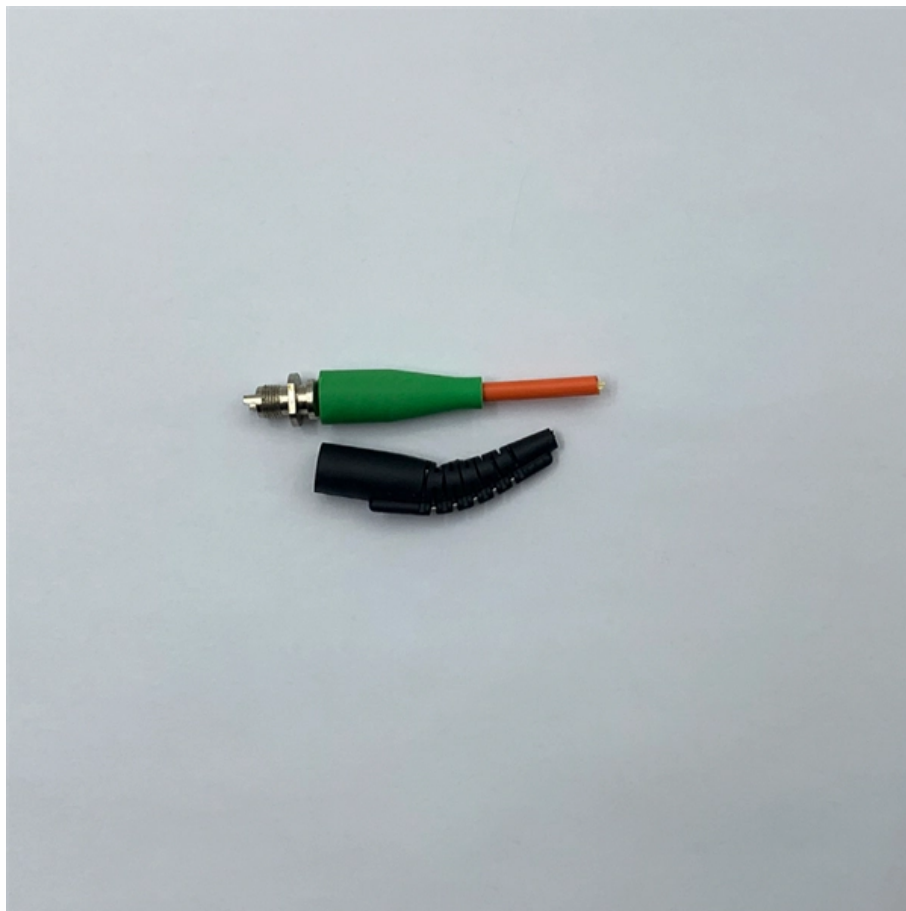

You can use partitions or divider panels to define multiple individual functional zones within your electrical enclosure. To create successful arrangements, it is important to specify both the box and the partition walls. In accordance with Hilti's CLIV approval, when CP 617 or CFS-P PA Firestop Putty Pad or Firestop Box Insert are installed on boxes on both sides of a wall as directed, the horizontal separation between outlet boxes on opposite sides of the wall may be less than 24" provided that the boxes are not. Homeowners typically pay a broad range for electrical box installation, driven by box type, wiring complexity, and local labor rates.
