Cut each wire with one clean cut - eliminating any grinding or touch-up. Cut the bottom wires first, in order as shown, from the underside of the tray. Rest the lower jaw of the cutters against the cradle

Flextray installation guide

Position bolt cutter blades near the cross wire and perpendicular to wire to be cut (see illustration above). Proper cut will make the assembly faster, easier and safer while minimizing grinding.
