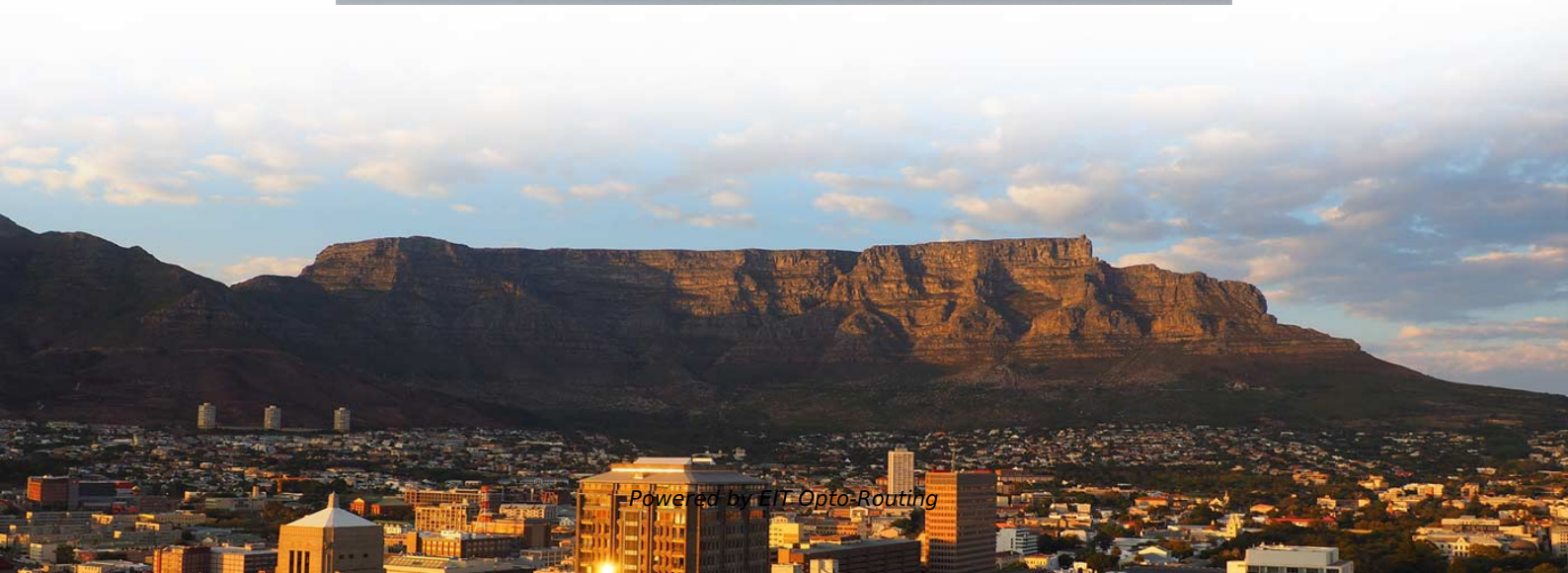


Installation Spacing of Enclosed Cable Tray Door Brackets

Traditionally, it has been recommended to install brackets approximately every 1 to 1. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require.
