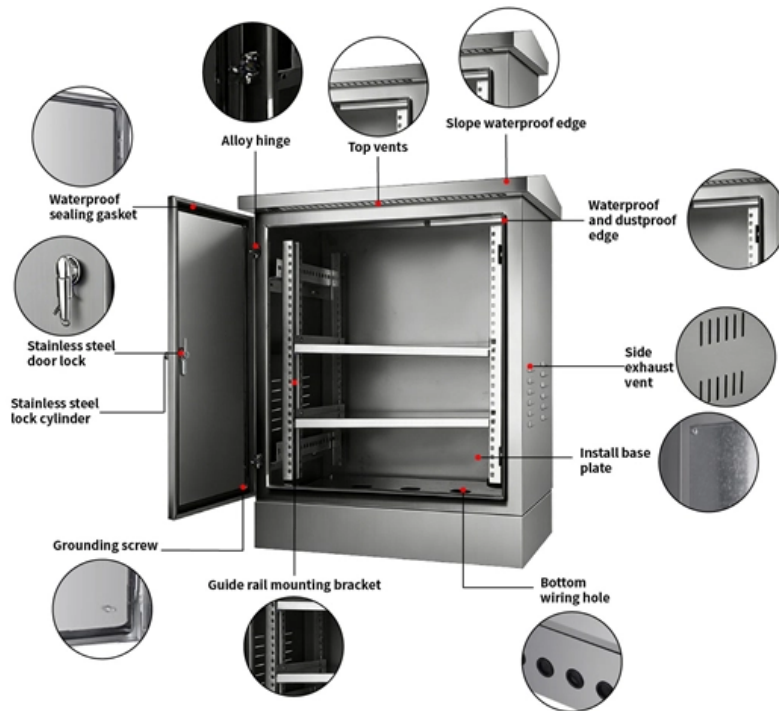


Is it safe to install fiber optic cables on a wall
